MSS Privacy Policy

- To share with our advisors and consultants;
- For a purpose that you consent to; and/or
- As we are required or authorised to by law.

We may disclose Personal Information:

- To third parties such as members and employees of the MSS Group and external service providers including our business partners, advisors, contractors and suppliers.
- Where required or authorised by law.
- Where you authorise us to disclose the Personal Information.

We may use and disclose your Personal Information outside Australia.

Where we engage third party external service providers and suppliers we will take reasonable steps to ensure that they comply with the Australian Privacy Principles and the Privacy Act 1988 but we do not accept responsibility for the misuse of Personal Information by those third parties.

Personal Information – Storage and security

We will take reasonable steps to keep Personal Information secure from unauthorised: use, loss, access, modification, and disclosure. We require our employees and contractors to protect the privacy of Personal Information.

If we no longer require your Personal Information we will take reasonable steps to destroy it.
